

HD CURB VIEW CAMERA

HELPS PROTECT YOUR VEHICLE WHEN PARKING

If equipped, available HD Curb View Camera shows you an image of the area directly in front of your vehicle while you're in a forward gear at low speeds. This may help you park or avoid nearby objects like poles, curbs or parked vehicles. You can select additional views on your camera display.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

- HD Curb View Camera supplements your direct vision and is helpful for parking and seeing curbs, blind spots, pavement markings, parked vehicles and the vehicle's surroundings
- Helps enhance your view to protect the fascia and air dam at low speeds while parking
- HD Curb View Camera automatically displays when shifting from REVERSE to a forward gear at low speeds

DOES MY VEHICLE HAVE THIS FEATURE?

- If your vehicle has a CURB VIEW button above the mode selector button, it has this feature
- If a camera view of the area in front of your vehicle displays in your infotainment system¹ when you shift from REVERSE to a forward gear at low speeds, your vehicle has HD Curb View Camera

HOW IT WORKS

- If equipped, the vehicle's camera system uses two digital forward-facing cameras (one camera on each side of the front fascia), in addition to a rear digital camera and digital video processing module. Together, they provide different views of the front and rear of the vehicle. Four views are shown in the centerstack:
 - Overhead View: Provides a top-down view of the scene immediately ahead of the front bumper
 - Curb View: Merges front cameras with overhead view to display area directly in front of the vehicle
 - Rear Camera View: Displays rear view to assist with parking and tight maneuvers
 - Rear Junction View: Wide-angle view from the rear camera
- HD Curb View Camera automatically displays in the infotainment system when shifting from REVERSE to a forward gear at low speeds
- You can also press the CURB VIEW button above the mode selector button at speeds slower than 7 miles per hour to see the HD Curb View Camera image
